**Competition Guideline**

---

**Description**

Breaking first appeared in the Bronx in 1974. The term was invented by DJ Kool Herk: he called "b-boys" and "b-girls" the young people dancing to his percussion "breaks" at street parties in Cedar Park since 1974.

In the early 80s, the b-boys of the Rock Steady Crew breathed new life into b-boying, inventing many new moves and taking it to a new level. The dance was first introduced outside of New York City in the movie "Flashdance" in 1983, featuring breaking in one of the episodes.

Although breaking is diverse in the number of variations available in the dance, it mainly consists of four types of moves: Toprock, Footwork, Power Moves, and Freezes. Breaking is usually performed to music containing drum breaks (drum solos), especially in hip-hop music, funk, soul and breakbeat, although modern trends allow a much wider variety of music within certain tempo and rhythm ranges.

Breaking is becoming more sophisticated, interesting and popular these days. Breaking gained worldwide recognition through its inclusion in the Olympic movement and continues to evolve as both a cultural expression and a competitive discipline within street culture.

---

**Overview**

Participants must submit a solo breaking performance video to music of their own choosing. The video must have a maximum duration of 1 minute (intro and outro not included) and may be recorded in either vertical or horizontal format. The performance must be filmed in one continuous take, with no editing or splicing, and the music must be played live during filming. Only new video material recorded in 2025–2026 is accepted. Filming may take place in any location, including dance studios, homes, streets, public spaces, or outdoor environments.

Previously used videos are not permitted, including footage submitted to other competitions, battles, or events unrelated to the KARDO Award-Competition. Participants are advised to ensure clear video quality, proper lighting, and audible music, so that movements, musicality, and overall performance can be accurately evaluated by the judges.

## How To Enter

---

### 1. Registration

The participant must register personal account on <https://rsv.ru> and complete the application process in their personal account on the official KARDO website <https://kardoaward.com> , selecting Breaking as the competition direction and the appropriate category.

### 2. Video Posting

The video must be posted on the participant's personal social media account with the official hashtags: #breaking #bboy #bgirl #KARDO #KARDO9 or cloud drive.

### 3. Video Upload

The participant must upload the video to their personal account on the KARDO website in the form of:

- One Playable Video File (MP4, MOV, AVI etc)
- A link to the video on social media or to cloud storage or any other free-access platform
- All links must remain active and publicly accessible until the end of the competition.

---

## Rules Online Competition

---

### 1. Intro & Outro Requirement

- Participants must add the official intro and outro to their video.
- These materials can be downloaded from: <http://www.worldkardoasia.com> Assets.

### 2. Video Recording

The participant must record a new solo breaking performance video :

- Maximum duration: 1 minute
- Video Format : Vertical or Horizontal (participant's choice)
- Filmed in one take (no editing or splicing)
- Music must be played live during filming (no added soundtrack)
- Filmed in 2025–2026 only
- Location is free (studio, home, street, public space, or outdoor area)

### 3. Expert Evaluation

The submitted videos are reviewed and evaluated by the Expert Council based on:

- Musicality & flow  
Coherence of movements, sense of rhythm, and interaction with music. Ability to work with accents, pauses, tempo, and dynamics of the track.
- Originality  
Individual style, unique movements, original decisions. Creative approach, unusual combinations and exit ideas. Recognizability of the participant.
- Composition  
Integrity and logic of the performance (beginning, development, conclusion). Balance between technique and musicality.
- Technique & cleanliness  
Level of technical preparation, including:
  - Footwork (floor-based movements using hands for support)
  - Power moves (acrobatic elements based on rotation and speed)
  - Freezes (controlled static poses used as accents or final points)Also evaluated: body control, precision, cleanliness, confidence, and absence of mistakes
- Character  
Presentation, confidence, charisma, and stage presence.

### 4. Scoring System & Penalties

- Scoring:
  - Each judge evaluates performances using a 10-point system, where 1 is the minimum and 10 is the maximum score.
  - Judges may deduct 1 to 10 points from the total score depending on the severity of rule violations.

- Penalty points may be applied for:
  - Falling
  - Unfinished round (interruption before the end of the musical square)
  - Use of overlay music instead of live music
- 5. Disqualification  
Participants will be disqualified in the following cases:
  - Use of old video material (filmed before January 1, 2025)
  - Use of editing, splicing, or video processing
  - Reuse of videos previously submitted to other competitions, battles, or selections not related to the KARDO Award
- 6. Online Qualification Results  
Participants advancing to the Grand Final shall be determined by the Expert Council in accordance with the official KARDO Regulations.

---

### **Additional Rules**

---

1. Any National Stage / Offline Qualification (if applicable)
  - Breaking offline qualifications are held in selected regions and countries.
  - Participants may attend any available offline qualification event in any country or region and compete there.
  - Winners of offline stages are determined based on live competition results.
2. Grand Final Participation
  - Status as Official KARDO Breaking Grand Finalist (International Participant)
  - They receive full access to official, competitive, recreational, and cultural programs of the KARDO Grand Final, subject to completed registration.
3. Final Qualification at Grand Final
  - During the Grand Final, an additional qualifying stage is held.
  - Participants from both online and offline qualifications compete together under equal conditions.
4. Selected online winners aged fourteen (14) years and above but under eighteen (18) years are required to be accompanied by a companion in order to attend and participate in the Grand Final. KARDO shall only cover the companion's accommodation (hotel) and meals. All other expenses, including but not limited to airfare and visa costs, shall be fully borne by the participant.

The format, requirements, and deadlines of the creative assignment are determined and announced by the KARDO Organizing Committee. All direction-specific competition criteria and technical regulations remain consistent and unchanged between the Online Qualification stage and the Offline Grand Final.

---

### **Additional Rules Bonnie and Clyde Category\***

---

1. Rule – Bonnie and Clyde Category
  - The Bonnie and Clyde category is a mixed pair category consisting of one B-Boy and one B-Girl.
  - This category is not formed during the online qualification stage.
  - Pairing is conducted only during the additional offline qualification held within the Grand Final.
2. Pair Formation
  - Qualified participants from the online and/or offline stages may be selected to form a Bonnie and Clyde pair during the additional offline selection.
  - Pairing is determined according to the competition mechanics and approval of the KARDO Organizing Committee.
  - Once formed, the pair competes together as a single unit in the Bonnie and Clyde category.
3. Competition & Results
  - The Bonnie and Clyde category produces one Champion Pair (Boy & Girl) at the Grand Final.
  - The Champion Pair is determined exclusively through live competition results during the Grand Final.
  - No online Champion title is awarded for the Bonnie and Clyde category.

### Important Notes

- Participation in the Bonnie and Clyde category is optional and does not affect individual results in 7 to Smoke B-Boy Pro or 7 to Smoke B-Girl Pro categories.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to adjust pairing mechanics if required by the competition format.

---

### KARDO Dance Night (Breaking Program)

---

1. KARDO Dance Night is an official non-competitive program held during the KARDO Grand Final.
2. The event is part of the Breaking cultural program, designed to celebrate street dance culture and community.
3. KARDO Dance Night includes:
  - Open cyphers and jam sessions
  - Showcase performances by invited dancers and finalists
  - Cultural exchange and networking activities
4. Important Notes
  - KARDO Dance Night is not a competition and does not involve judging or scoring.
  - Participation in KARDO Dance Night is optional and does not affect competition results.
  - The Organizing Committee reserves the right to invite selected participants or guests to perform.
