1 INTRO & OUTRO REQUIREMENT

- Participants must add the official intro and outro to their video.
- These materials can be downloaded from: <https://www.worldkardoasia.com> Assets.

2 VIDEO RECORDING

- The participant must record a new solo performance video:
 - Duration: 60–90 seconds
 - Filmed in 2025–2026
 - May be a single continuous run or edited footage
 - Indoor or outdoor locations allowed
 - No artificial/modified obstacles, safety mats, or soft landing zones
 - Previously used videos are not permitted

Competition Guideline

Description

Parkour is the art of efficient movement and overcoming obstacles of varying difficulty using only the capabilities of the human body. Originating as a discipline focused on practicality, control, and safety, parkour has evolved into a global movement culture combining athleticism, creativity, and discipline.

Within the KARDO framework, parkour is recognized as both a street sport and a cultural practice that emphasizes control, precision, adaptability, and respect for the environment. Performances highlight the athlete's ability to move fluently through space while maintaining safety and technical integrity.

Overview

Participants must submit a parkour performance video created specifically for the KARDO Award-Competition. The video must have a duration of 60–90 seconds (intro and outro not included).

The video may consist of a single continuous run or edited footage, provided that all footage is recorded during 2025–2026. Filming may take place indoors or outdoors. The use of artificial or modified obstacles that reduce risk (such as safety mats or soft landing zones) is strictly prohibited.

Previously used video materials or footage submitted to other competitions, projects, or selections unrelated to KARDO are not permitted.

Online Submission, June 9th, 2026 – July 15th, 2026

Grand Final, September 16th, 2026 – September 20th, 2026

How To Enter

1. Registration

The participant must register personal account on <https://rsv.ru> and complete the application process in their personal account on the official KARDO website <http://kardoaward.com> , selecting Parkour as the competition direction and the appropriate category.

2. Video Posting

The video must be posted on the participant's personal social media account with the official hashtags: #parkour #KARDO #KARDO9 or cloud drive.

3. Video Upload

The participant must upload the video to their personal account on the KARDO website in the form of:

- One Playable Video File (MP4, MOV, AVI etc)
- A link to the video on social media or to cloud storage or any other free-access platform
- All links must remain active and publicly accessible until the end of the competition.

Rules Online Competition

1. Intro & Outro Requirement

- Participants must add the official intro and outro to their video.
- These materials can be downloaded from: <https://www.worldkardoasia.com> Assets.

2. Video Recording

The participant must record a new solo performance video:

- Duration: 60–90 seconds
- Filmed in 2025–2026 only
- Intro and outro are not included in the timing
- Single run or edited footage allowed
- Filming locations: indoor or outdoor
- Video must clearly show the athlete's full body and landings must be visible for evaluation purposes.
- The video must be created exclusively for KARDO

3. Prohibited Conditions

The following will result in disqualification:

- Use of safety mats, foam pits, soft landing zones, gymnastic modules
- Use of spring-loaded surfaces, trampolines, acrobatic tracks, sand pits
- Use of old video materials (before 2025)
- Reuse of videos submitted to other competitions

4. Tatami sheets are permitted only as floor covering, not as impact-absorbing elements.

5. Scoring System & Penalties

- Judges score in 0.5-point increments.
 - Final score is calculated as the average of all judges' scores.
 - Scoring :
 - Difficulty (0–10 points)
Assessment of the technical and physical difficulty of demonstrated elements, combinations, and diversity of technical directions.
 - Safety (0–5 points)
Quality of landings, control, stability, accuracy, and absence of falls or dangerous mistakes.
 - Technicality (0–5 points)
Cleanliness and precision of execution, confidence, and preservation of technique at speed or high intensity.
 - Variety (0–10 points)
Diversity of movements, techniques, obstacles, creative solutions, and individual style.
 - Connectivity (0–10 points)
Flow, rhythm, density of movement, smooth transitions, and logical structure without long pauses or breakdowns.
 - Penalty points may be applied for:
 - Time Violations
 - Shorter by 1 second: –3 points
 - Shorter by 2 seconds: –5 points
 - Shorter by 3 seconds or more: Disqualification
 - Exceeding maximum duration: footage beyond the limit is not evaluated
 - Tie-Break Priority :
 - Safety
 - Difficulty
 - Technicality
- If still tied, the higher single-judge score prevails.

6. Disqualification

Participants will be disqualified for:

- Use of prohibited filming conditions
- Safety violations
- Submission of old or reused video materials
- Non-compliance with technical or timing requirements

7. Online Qualification Results

Based on expert evaluation, the list of participants advancing to the next stage (TOP lists) will be published on the official KARDO website.

Additional Rules

1. Any Offline Qualification (if applicable)
 - Parkour offline qualifications are held in selected regions and countries.
 - Participants may attend any available offline qualification event in any country or region and compete there.
 - Winners of offline stages are determined based on live competition results.
2. Grand Final Participation
 - Status as Official KARDO Parkour Grand Finalist (International Participant)
 - Qualified participants receive Official KARDO Parkour Grand Finalist status and compete in the Grand Final according to KARDO Regulations.
3. Final Qualification at Grand Final
 - During the Grand Final, an additional qualifying stage is held.
 - Participants from both online and offline qualifications compete together under equal conditions.
4. Selected online winners aged fourteen (14) years and above but under eighteen (18) years are required to be accompanied by a companion in order to attend and participate in the Grand Final. KARDO shall only cover the companion's accommodation (hotel) and meals. All other expenses, including but not limited to airfare and visa costs, shall be fully borne by the participant.
5. The format, requirements, and deadlines of the creative assignment are determined and announced by the KARDO Organizing Committee. All direction-specific competition criteria and technical regulations remain consistent and unchanged between the Online Qualification stage and the Offline Grand Final.

- a. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend formats, criteria, and schedules in accordance with KARDO Regulations.
