**RULES – ONLINE COMPETITION**

- 2 VIDEO RECORDING**
  - Maximum duration: 60 seconds (intro & outro not included).

  - The video must demonstrate effective use of park or street elements and original lines.
  - Ensure clear camera angles showing full execution, landing, and exit of each trick.

**Competition Guideline**

---

**Description**

BMX is an extreme street sport that combines technical tricks, power, balance, and creativity performed on a BMX bicycle. Riders demonstrate control, originality, and mastery of transitions, rotations, grinds, and amplitude across street spots or skate parks.

Within the KARDO framework, BMX is recognized as a competitive street sport that values difficulty, amplitude, execution quality, variety, creativity, and effective use of the riding space.

---

**Overview**

Participants must submit a BMX performance video created specifically for the KARDO Award-Competition. The video must showcase the rider's best tricks and combinations performed during the 2025–2026 period.

The maximum duration of the video is 60 seconds (intro and outro not included). Musical accompaniment and editing are permitted, provided they do not interfere with the visibility or evaluation of tricks.

## How To Enter

---

### 1. Registration

The participant must register personal account on <https://rsv.ru> and complete the application process in their personal account on the official KARDO website <http://kardoaward.com> , selecting BMX as the competition direction.

### 2. Video Posting

The video must be posted on the participant's personal social media account with the official hashtags: #BMX #KARDO #KARDO9 or cloud drive.

### 3. Video Upload

The participant must upload the video to their personal account on the KARDO website in the form of:

- One Playable Video File (MP4, MOV, AVI etc)
- A link to the video on social media or to cloud storage or any other free-access platform
- All links must remain active and publicly accessible until the end of the competition.

---

## Rules Online Competition

---

### 1. Intro & Outro Requirement

- Participants must add the official intro and outro to their video.
- These materials can be downloaded from: <https://worldkardoasia.com> Assets.

### 1. Video Recording

- Maximum duration: 60 seconds
- Video format: vertical or horizontal (at the participant's choice).
- Filmed in 2025–2026 only
- The opening and closing credits are not included in the running time.
- The participant must perform all tricks personally.
- The video must demonstrate effective use of spot or park elements (funboxes, rails, banks, quarters, etc.), including original lines and transitions.
- Ensure clear camera angles showing the full execution, landing, and exit of each trick
- Editing and music should not distract from trick evaluation
- Tricks shown beyond the established time limit will not be considered in the evaluation.
- Use of AI-generated or digitally altered trick footage is prohibited.
- Copyright violations will result in disqualification in accordance with the KARDO Regulations.

### 2. Expert Evaluation

Each performance is evaluated by the Expert Council. Scoring is conducted on a 10-point scale for each criterion, with a maximum total of 30 points. Each participant is evaluated according to three criteria :

- **Difficulty**  
Technical complexity of tricks, combinations, rotations, grinds, and transitions.
- **Amplitude**  
Height, power, speed, and dynamic expression of tricks.
- **Quality of Execution**  
Clean landings, control, confidence, and completeness of trick execution.

### 3. Additional Factors Influencing the Score

- **Trick combinations (combos):**  
Combinations of complex tricks using manuals (a trick involving balancing on the rear wheel of the bike without pedaling), fakies (riding the bike backward), or other technically difficult transitions are evaluated with an increased difficulty coefficient.
- **Trick variety**  
Use of different types of tricks (technical, amplitude, rotations, grinds, etc.) demonstrating the rider's wellrounded skill level.
- **Use of spot/park**  
Effective use of obstacles such as rails, boxes, banks, quarters, and creative lines.
- **Creativity & originality**  
Unique tricks, uncommon spots, and original approaches.

### 4. Scoring System & Penalties

Penalty points may be deducted for:

- Fall
- Incomplete trick execution
- Poor execution (e.g., foot touching the ground)
- Use of old video materials (recorded before 2025)
- Tricks shown beyond the 60-second limit are not evaluated.

### 5. Disqualification

Participants will be disqualified for:

- Use of video materials recorded before 2025
- Reuse or editing with other riders' tricks
- Severe violation of video requirements or misrepresentation of authorship

6. Online Qualification Results

Based on expert evaluation, the list of participants advancing to the next stage (TOP lists) will be published on the official KARDO website.

### Additional Rules

1. Any Offline Qualification (if applicable)
  - BMX offline qualifications may be held in selected regions and countries.
  - Participants may attend any available offline qualification event in any country or region and compete there.
  - Winners are determined based on live competition results.
2. Grand Final Participation
  - Status as Official KARDO BMX Grand Finalist (International Participant)
  - Full access to official, competitive, recreational, and cultural programs of the KARDO Grand Final
3. Final Qualification at Grand Final
  - During the Grand Final, an additional qualifying stage may be held.
  - Participants from online and offline qualifications compete together under equal conditions.
4. Selected online winners aged fourteen (14) years and above but under eighteen (18) years are required to be accompanied by a companion in order to attend and participate in the Grand Final. KARDO shall only cover the companion's accommodation (hotel) and meals. All other expenses, including but not limited to airfare and visa costs, shall be fully borne by the participant.
5. This BMX World Online Competition Guideline is a direction-specific supplement to the official KARDO IX Regulations (Season 2026). In the event of any discrepancy, inconsistency, or conflict between this Guideline and the official KARDO IX Regulations, the provisions of the KARDO IX Regulations shall prevail and be binding.
6. Any disputes, appeals, or claims arising from the evaluation process, qualification results, or participation status shall be reviewed and resolved in accordance with the procedures established in the official KARDO IX Regulations. The decision of the Organizing Committee and/or the authorized Appeal Committee shall be final and binding.

The format and deadlines are determined by the Organizing Committee. All direction-specific competition criteria and technical regulations remain consistent and unchanged between the Online Qualification stage and the Offline Grand Final.
