ROLLERBLADING PRO : TOP 5 SELECTED ONLINE FINALISTS\*

**Professional (PRO)** – The PRO category reflects participants who already represent rollerblading at a competitive, professional, or semi-professional level, regardless of nationality. PRO participants are expected to:

- Show high difficulty, strong control, and confident execution
- Demonstrate advanced rollerblading techniques, including complex trick combinations
- Maintain clean landings, stable balance, and continuous flow throughout the run
- Compete under full professional judging standards without simplified requirements
- Be capable of performing at Grand Final level, alongside international finalists



ROLLERBLADING AMATEUR : TOP 3 SELECTED ONLINE FINALISTS\*

**Amateur (AMATEUR)** – The AMATEUR category ensures fair competitive balance, allowing developing athletes to compete under equal conditions without being directly compared to PRO-level performers. Within the KARDO competition framework, AMATEUR participants:

- Demonstrate basic to intermediate rollerblading techniques
- Focus on clean execution, control, and correct fundamentals rather than extreme difficulty
- Are evaluated with the same judging criteria, but within the context of amateur-level execution
- Participate in the same selection system, but ranked separately from PRO participants
- May progress to higher levels in future seasons as skill and experience increase

2 VIDEO RECORDING

- Maximum duration: 60 seconds (intro & outro not included).
- Video format: vertical or horizontal (at participant's choice).

---

**Description**

Rollerblading is an extreme street sport based on skating and performing technical tricks using inline skates. The discipline originated from urban skating culture and has evolved into a highly technical and expressive form of street sports, combining speed, balance, creativity, and control.

Modern rollerblading includes various styles such as street skating, park skating, rail and ledge tricks, jumps, spins, and complex combinations. The discipline values originality, flow, technical difficulty, cleanliness of execution, and confident interaction with urban or park environments.

As part of the KARDO Award-Competition, Rollerblading represents the spirit of street culture, freedom of movement, and creative self-expression through motion.

---

**Overview**

Participants must submit a solo rollerblading performance video demonstrating their skills, creativity, and control. The video must have a maximum duration of 1 minute (intro and outro not included) and may be recorded in vertical or horizontal format.

The performance must be filmed in one continuous take, without editing or splicing. Only new video material recorded in 2025–2026 is accepted. Filming may take place in street locations, skate parks, public spaces, or other suitable environments that reflect street culture and allow safe execution of rollerblading tricks. Previously used videos, including materials submitted to other competitions, battles, or events not related to the KARDO Award-Competition, are strictly prohibited. Participants are advised to ensure clear video quality, proper lighting, and full visibility of movements, so that the judges can accurately evaluate technique, flow, and overall performance.

### How To Enter

---

#### 1. Registration

The participant must register personal account on <https://rsv.ru> and complete the application process in their personal account on the official KARDO website <http://kardoaward.com> selecting Kickscooter as the competition direction.

#### 2. Video Posting

The video must be posted on the participant's personal social media account using the official hashtags: #rollerblading #inlineskating #KARDO #KARDO9 or cloud drive

#### 3. Video Upload

The participant must upload the video to their personal account on the KARDO website in the form of:

- One Playable Video File (MP4, MOV, AVI etc)
- A link to the video on social media or to cloud storage or any other free-access platform
- All links must remain active and publicly accessible until the end of the competition.

---

### Rules Online Competition

---

#### 1. Intro & Outro Requirement

- Participants must add the official intro and outro to their video.
- These materials can be downloaded from: <https://worldkardoasia.com> Assets.

#### 2. Video Recording

- Maximum duration: 60 seconds
- Video format: vertical or horizontal (at the participant's choice).
- Filmed in 2025–2026 only
- The opening and closing credits are not included in the running time.
- The video must include 6 to 10 tricks performed at a single location or spot.
- All tricks must be filmed during a single riding session.
- Tricks shown beyond the established time limit will not be considered in the evaluation.
- The participant must perform all tricks personally.
- It is recommended to ensure good image quality and camera angles that clearly show the execution of tricks.
- The video should show the full amplitude of the trick, the landing, and the exit.
- Musical accompaniment and editing style are at the participant's discretion but should not interfere with the perception of the tricks.
- Use of AI-generated or digitally altered trick footage is prohibited.
- Copyright violations will result in disqualification in accordance with the KARDO Regulations.

#### 3. Expert Evaluation

Each participant is evaluated according to five criteria:

- Overall Impact — up to 20 points  
Assessed by : overall presentation, flow of the material; rider's confidence and presence; visual impressiveness and emotional impact; the impression of the performance as a complete rider presentation.
- Style / Flow — up to 20 points  
Assessed by: individuality of riding, flow, expressiveness of movements, characteristic execution style, and overall sense of speed and balance.
- Cleanliness — up to 20 points

- Assessed by: trick stability; accuracy of landings, under-rotations, skids, touches, and errors affecting trick quality.
- Technical Difficulty — up to 20 points  
Assessed by: difficulty of the tricks themselves; variety of rotations, flips, grinds, slides; risk and execution precision; presence of complex angled combinations or non-standard solutions.
  - Variety — up to 20 points  
Assessed by: number of different trick groups; absence of repetitions; balance between technical, stylish, and speed elements; creativity in angles, approaches, and lines.
4. Scoring System & Penalties  
Penalty points are deducted from the final score in the following cases:
- Fall or incomplete execution of a trick.
  - Poor execution (e.g., placing a foot on the ground).
  - Failure to include the required number of tricks (fewer than 6), or using other riders' tricks or old video materials, will result in participant disqualification

---

### Additional Rules

---

1. Any Offline Qualification (if applicable)
  - Rollerblading offline qualifications may be held in selected regions and countries.
  - Participants may attend any available offline qualification event in any country or region and compete there.
  - Winners are determined based on live competition results.
2. Grand Final Participation
  - Status as Official KARDO Rollerblading Grand Finalist (International Participant)
  - Full access to official, competitive, recreational, and cultural programs of the KARDO Grand Final
3. Final Qualification at Grand Final
  - During the Grand Final, an additional qualifying stage may be held.
  - Participants from online and offline qualifications compete together under equal conditions.
4. Selected online winners aged sixteen (16) years and above but under eighteen (18) years are required to be accompanied by a companion in order to attend and participate in the Grand Final. KARDO shall only cover the companion's accommodation (hotel) and meals. All other expenses, including but not limited to airfare and visa costs, shall be fully borne by the participant.
5. This Rollerblading World Online Competition Guideline is a direction-specific supplement to the official KARDO IX Regulations (Season 2026). In the event of any discrepancy, inconsistency, or conflict between this Guideline and the official KARDO IX Regulations, the provisions of the KARDO IX Regulations shall prevail and be binding.
6. Any disputes, appeals, or claims arising from the evaluation process, qualification results, or participation status shall be reviewed and resolved in accordance with the procedures established in the official KARDO IX Regulations. The decision of the Organizing Committee and/or the authorized Appeal Committee shall be final and binding.

The format and deadlines are determined by the Organizing Committee. All direction-specific competition criteria and technical regulations remain consistent and unchanged between the Online Qualification stage and the Offline Grand Final.
